BTEC Level 2 Diploma in Performing Arts – Course Code DPM2

This is a brand new full time course for performers with disabilities.

The course is offered by City College Plymouth working in partnership with Attik Dance. This course is an industry focused route for those students who are very passionate about performance and want to train further in this specialism.

Students will have the opportunity to develop their practice as an individual and as a member of a performance ensemble. They will be involved right from the start in an in-depth experience of the performing arts. The course is broad based and students will develop skills in dance, physical theatre and performance making

The units that students will study on the course all lead to performances - some of these will be large scale public performances (indoors and outdoors).
